Lane Closures; Travel Delays for Resurfacing of State Route 339 South of Yerington

CARSON CITY, Nev. – Lane closures and travel delays will begin Sept. 23 on sections of State Route 339 south of Mason and Yerington as the Nevada Department of Transportation resurfaces the roadway.

Beginning Sept. 23 through November, lane closures will be in place from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. weekdays on sections of the road between Rebbecka Drive and the State Route 208 intersection south of Mason. Pilot cars will alternate directions of traffic through the work zone as the road is resurfaced, with up to 30-minute travel delays to be expected.

Side roads and driveways will remain accessible during construction, with brief access interruptions as paving takes place. Residents should also anticipate increased construction-related heavy truck traffic on Second Street as construction materials are hauled to and from the project area.

Drivers are advised to plan alternate routes and avoid the area if possible. Through traffic will be able to use State Route 208 as a nearby alternate route.

Over-dimensional vehicles over 12-feet wide will be prohibited on the section of roadway until construction completes.

The resurfacing will provide a smoother, restored roadway surface for the traveling public. Roadway cattle guards will also be replaced, and roadway drainage improved.

SAFE WORK ZONE DRIVING TIPS

- Plan ahead and leave extra travel time.
- Always buckle up.
- Pay attention. Normal speed limits may be reduced, traffic lanes may be changed and people and vehicles may be working near the road.
- Slow to posted work zone speed limits.
- Continue to pay attention to work zone signs, even in areas of long-term road work.
