Non-Compliant Sex Offender Arrested in Dayton

Dayton, NV – On March 1, 2025 Lyon County Sheriff's Office deputies assigned to the Western Command Patrol Area and the Lyon County Sheriff's Office Sex Offender Task Force conducted a traffic stop on an unregistered vehicle US Highway 50 near Retail Drive in Dayton, NV. Upon contacting the driver, identified as 34 year old Dayton resident Quincy Lee Grubenman, deputies discovered Grubenman was registered sex offender who was out of compliance with his registration requirements.

Grubenman was arrested and booked into the Lyon County Jail on one felony count of failing to register/violating registration requirements.

The Lyon County Sheriff's Office Sex Offender Task Force is committed to ensuring that all registered sex offenders in Lyon County comply with their legal obligations. The Task Force conducts routine compliance checks to verify registration adherence, reinforcing its dedication to public safety. These proactive efforts play a crucial role in protecting Lyon County residents and maintaining community well-being.

The mission of the task force is to ensure 100% compliance among registered sexual offenders in Lyon County. For those who choose not to meet their legal obligations, the Lyon County Sheriff's Office will take swift and decisive action to hold them accountable.
